

## BULLETIN BOARD CONTEST RULES

1. Number of entries:
  - a. If a club has overlapping grades (7-12), or some variation of this, it should be allowed one entry in each division, junior and senior, with the entry clearly marked as to the level of the student participants.
  - b. If a club has only grades 9-12, it should be allowed only one entry.
  - c. If a club has grades 7-9, it should be allowed only one entry. (2/13/98)
2. The bulletin board design **must** follow the theme of the convention, which must be visible somewhere on the entry. (11/6/99)
3. The bulletin board must be an original entry created during the period immediately following the last convention and immediately before the coming convention, by a member in good standing in the local school club and member of LTLA.
4. The size of the entry must be twenty-two inches by twenty-eight inches (22" x 28"--regular poster size).
5. The bulletin board must have been on exhibit in the school library for at least one week and verified by an attached photograph.
6. A facsimile (copy) of the bulletin board should be a scale replica (miniature) on poster paper or any similar materials.
7. A facsimile (copy) of the entry must be made and brought to the convention. Only one entry for each club will be judged. (2/18/2000)
8. Photographs of the bulletin board will not be accepted as the entry. (2/18/2000)
9. Entries must be submitted on Friday of the convention. To be eligible for the contest, all entries must be checked in by 2:00 p.m. that day. (Please have your entry ready to submit during the registration period.) (10/17/98)
10. A 3x5 card should be used for identification of the bulletin board poster. Identification should include: name of the school, name or names of Library/Media Club member(s), and grade level. Please permanently attach (tape or staple) the card and the photograph to the back of the poster.
11. Any entry not complying with the rules will be disqualified before judging.
12. Judging will be based on the following:

A. ADHERENCE TO THE CONVENTION THEME	15 points _____
B. ORIGINALITY	20 points _____
C. CREATIVITY	20 points _____
D. RELATIONSHIP TO BOOKS AND READING AND LIBRARIES	25 points _____
E. OVER-ALL EFFECTIVENESS	20 points _____
13. Judging will be the responsibility of the committee after the LTLA/hotel liaison person and the chairman of the Student Relations Committee have secured the room for the judging.
14. Judges will return score sheets to the committee.

15. The score sheets will be returned to the individual schools.
